#### 20. DEFINITIONS

- (a) "Act" means the Residential Tenancies Act 1987 including any amendments.
  - "Application" means this Application to enter into a Residential Tenancy Agreement.
  - "Business Day" means any day except a Sunday or public holiday in Western Australia.
  - "Lessor" means the person/entity with the authority to lease the Premises.
  - "Option Fee" means a payment as referred to in section 27(2)(a) of the Act. The amount of the Option Fee is specified in Part A of this application. The amount of the Option Fee is capped as follows:
  - (i) where the weekly rental under the Residential Tenancy Agreement is \$500 or less, an Option Fee of up to \$50 is payable;
  - (ii) where the weekly rental under the Residential Tenancy Agreement exceeds \$500, an Option Fee of up to \$100 is payable;
  - (iii) where the Residential Tenancy Agreement is for residential premises south of the 26th parallel of south latitude and the weekly rent is \$1,200 or more, an Option Fee of up to \$1,200 is payable.

"Premises" means the address specified on the first page of this document. Any items included or excluded will appear in Part A of the proposed Residential Tenancy Agreement.

"Property Manager" means the real estate agent appointed by the Lessor to lease and manage the Premises.

"Residential Tenancy Agreement" means an agreement in writing in the form prescribed by the Act, comprising of Parts A, B and C. Part C will include additional special conditions as agreed between the parties.

"You" or "Your" means the person or persons making the Application to Lease the Premises.

- (b) All acts and things that the Lessor is required or empowered to do may be done by the Lessor or their Property Manager.
- 21. You agree that for the purpose of this Application, the Lessor or Property Manager may make enquiries of the persons given as referees, next of kin or emergency contacts provided by You, and also make enquiries of such other persons or agencies as the Lessor may see fit.

The personal information You give in this Application or collected from other sources is necessary for the Lessor or Property Manager to verify Your identity, to process and evaluate the Application, to manage the tenancy and to conduct the Property Manager's business. ### ANNEXURE A SPECIAL CONDITIONS

#### 1) OVERDUE RENT

The tenant agrees to pay all rental by the due date and is aware that failure to do so will result in a 'Notice of Termination' being issued if the rental due remains unpaid after three days (3).

### 2) POOLS

The tenants are aware and agree that upon vacation of the property they must provide the Agent with chemical report from a reputable and well known pool company showing that all chemical levels are correct and the pool water is in healthy condition. If any expense then this will be the tenant's responsibility.

### 3) WATER READING

The tenant agrees to pay the special water metre reading fee for the Water Corporation to read the meter at the end of the tenancy. Ordinary fee: \$16.31 or Urgent if necessary: \$42.60 (The urgent water readings are for break lease or termination situations)

#### 4) CHANGE OF OCCUPATION

The tenant agrees to notify Force Real Estate within 14 days of any new place of occupation and provide them with the phone number. Failure to provide us within 14 days under the *Residential Tenancy Act* it may incur up to \$1000 fine.

#### 5) DISHONOURED CHEQUES

The tenant acknowledges that if a cheque is dishonoured by the bank a \$35.00 dishonour fee will be payable to Force Real Estate.

#### 6) PETS – REFER TO PET ANNEXURE

### 7) INSPECTIONS

The tenant understands that an inspection of the property will be carried out every 3 months though first inspection will be after six weeks from the commencement of the tenant lease. 7-14 days notice will be given prior to the inspection.

Under the residential tenancies act the tenant must allow the agent access to the property and provide the agent with the alarm code and all keys if the locks had been authorised to be changed.

The tenant is aware and accepts that photographs will be taken of the property during routine inspections. These photos are for the purpose of showing the owners the condition of the property only, every effort will be taken to respect the tenant's privacy.

#### 8) LAWNS, GARDENS

The owner agrees to pay 0% of all water consumed at the premises, the tenant is responsible for 100% of all water consumed, the tenant must turn off reticulation when the water ban takes effect, and switch it back on once allowed, tenant is to check with the water corporation if unsure. Hand watering will be required if lawns become dry during water ban period.

#### 9) VEHICLES

Vehicles are not, permitted to be parked on lawns at any time, if it has been found that the cars have been parked on the lawn and any damage to the lawn or the reticulation are found it will be at the tenants cost. The tenant also agrees to use drip trays in the carport/garage to prevent oil stains from vehicles.

#### 10) VACATING

- A. The tenant is aware if this agreement is a fixed term agreement then it may be ended by agreement in writing between the lessor and the tenant; or if either the lessor or tenant does not want to renew the agreement, by giving written notice of termination. The notice must be given to the other party at least 30 days prior to the date on which vacant possession of the premises is to be delivered to the lessor. The notice may be given at any time up until the end of the fixed term but cannot take effect until the term ends.
- B. The tenant is aware that during the period of notice given by the tenant the Owner/Agent may show premises to prospective tenants after giving reasonable notice being 21-48 hours.
- C. The tenants are aware that rent will be charged until the key is delivered to the owner/agent when the property is vacated. (This applies when keys are handed in after the vacation date.)

#### 11) BREAKING YOUR LEASE – IMPORTANT NOTICE TO TENANTS

If the tenant wishes to vacate the premises before the ending of the tenancy the following conditions will apply:

- A. The tenant will pay:
  - The rent and all other outgoings on the property until it is relet on behalf of the Owner.
  - Any damages and costs reasonably incurred by the Owner in respect of the reletting of the premises including-
    - (a) Reimbursement to the owner of the unexpired portion of the letting fee charged at the commencement of the tenancy;
    - (b) Reimbursement to the owner for the final bond inspection charge.
    - (c) Reimbursement to the owner the cost of tenants checks on the national tenancy database.
  - 3. Advertising costs
  - 4. Responsible for the upkeep of the property until it is relet

### 12) MAINTENANCE

The tenant is aware that all maintenance request must be in writing, Force Real Estate will not accept any verbal request unless in case of an emergency only. If any work by contractors is deemed to be caused by the tenant they will be held liable for such repairs.

### 13) RETICULATION

Should there be reticulation at the property, the tenant is aware that they are responsible for the general upkeep of the system. I.e. keeping sprinklers free from sand and debris. It is the Tenants responsibility to replace sprinklers if they are not working at any time. The Tenant is advised to check the sprinklers on occupying the property and if they are not working and some are broken – report this to Agent to ensure they are all operating correctly at the start of the tenancy. Should the system not be operational for any reason it is the Tenants responsibility to hand water all areas until the system is fixed.
